New business – Solicitor Legg proposed changes to the Zoning Ordinance. Ordinance 2016-3 has been sent to CCPC, they have 30 days to respond. 16 items were negotiated with the Attorney General's office to be changed. Roger reviewed the changes to be made, see attached. There were also several definition changes. There will be a hearing in April regarding the changes, and it most likely will be adopted in May.

Judy recommended that we pass these changes on to the supervisors for their approval, Dave Herr seconded, all were in favor.

Roger said that an ordinance will be presented tomorrow night at the Board of Supervisor's meeting to reduce the size of the planning commission from 9 to 7.

Dave Herr reminded us that the Ethics forms need to be completed.

Dean motioned to adjourn, Judy seconded.
